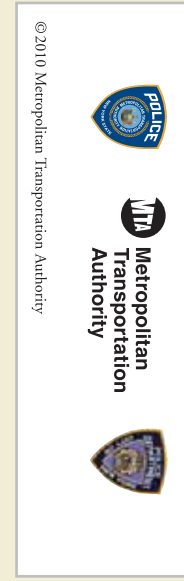

**The Map**

This map is a guide to MTA subways and railroads. Buses stop at or near over 400 of the 468 subway stations; at major connections, boxes show MTA buses and other transportation services.

Bus maps are available in each borough on board buses or by calling 718-330-1234.

**Fares:**

MTA subway and local bus fare is \$2.75; express buses cost \$5.50.

**MetroCard:**  
Buy Unlimited Ride or Pay-Per-Ride MetroCard at subway stations and more than 4,000 merchants.

**Unlimited Rides:**

1-Day Fun Pass (\$9.25) — unlimited rides on subways and local buses from first use until 3 a.m. the following day; available at MetroCard Vending Machines and selected merchants.

7-Day (\$27), 14-Day (\$51.50), or 30-Day (\$89) Unlimited Ride MetroCard — unlimited rides on local buses and subways from first use until midnight of the 7th, 14th, or 30th day. Express Bus Plus MetroCard (\$45) — unlimited rides on express buses, local buses, and subways from first use until midnight of the 7th day.

**Pay-Per-Ride:**

Purchase from \$1.50 to \$30; fare is deducted when card is used. Available at MetroCard Vending Machines and selected merchants. Transfer free within two hours.

**Reduced-Fare MetroCard:**

Available for senior citizens, people presenting a Medicare card, and for people with disabilities. For more information on reduced-fare MetroCard services with full-hour restrictions on express buses and commuter rail (meat), for application or information, call 718-242-4999 or 212-411-8228 (TTY).

**Railroads:**

Reduced fares are distance-based. MetroCard is available on Metro-North Railroad, Long Island Rail Road, and Amtrak. For more information, call 718-242-4999 or 212-411-8228 (TTY).

**Service Note**

The subway map depicts weekday service. Service differs by time of day and is sometimes affected by construction. Overhead directional signs on platforms show weekend, evening, and late night service. This information is also available on [mta.info](http://mta.info): click on "Maps" in the top menu bar, then select "Individual Subway Line Maps". For construction-related service changes, click on "Planned Service Changes" in the top menu bar. This information is also at station entrances and on platform columns of affected lines.
